Post-graduation plans collected on 91.90% of BS graduates.

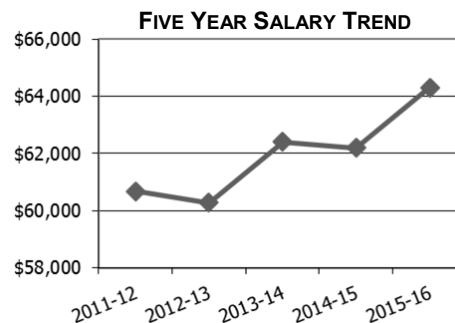

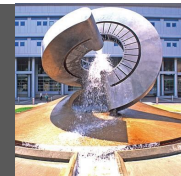
