



HOW TO USE YOUR CO-OP & SUMMER INTERNSHIP CREDIT

The following information is supplied by the specific department. It does change occasionally, so please verify with your department before registering for credit.

NOTE: Each term/semester of internship or co-op is 1 credit.

BME: 1 credit of BME 001 taken in a Fall or Spring term may be counted as credit towards the missed BME 200 or BME 300 course. Additionally, credit of BME 001 earned during a Summer term can count towards engineering technical free electives.

CHE: Up to 2 credits of CBE1 can be counted towards CHE electives. Students may select to take Professor Root's Special Topics course for 1 credit to round out a 3-credit group (contact CBE). Srs preferred.

Civ.E: Up to 3 credits of CEE 1 can be applied to engineering electives.

CMPE: 1 credit of ECE 1 may be counted towards Professional Electives

EE: 1 credit of ECE 1 may be counted towards the advanced course electives.

Env.E: Up to 3 credits of CEE 1 can be applied to Professional Electives.

EM: Up to 3 credits of EMA 1 may be applied toward technical electives.

EP: Up to 3 credits of NE 1 may be counted towards technical electives.

GLE: 1 credit of GLE 1 can be applied toward technical electives

IE: Up to 3 credits of ISYE 1 may be counted towards Professional Electives

MS&E: Up to 3 credits of MSE 1 can be counted toward MS&E electives.

ME: Up to 3 credits of ME 1 may be counted towards technical electives.

NE: Up to 3 credits of NE 1 may be counted towards technical electives.
